This Task Order pertains to an Agreement by and between City of Osage Beach, Missouri, ("OWNER"), and HDR Engineering, Inc. ("ENGINEER"), dated June 26, 2015, ("the Agreement"). Engineer shall perform services on the project described below as provided herein and in the Agreement. This Task Order shall not be binding until it has been properly signed by both parties. Upon execution, this Task Order shall supplement the Agreement as it pertains to the project described below.

Heggemann, Inc. was awarded the construction contract #OB19-010 for the Swiss Village Well No. 3 on July 18, 2019 by the Board of Aldermen for the contract of not to exceed \$553,292. Two additional contract modifications were approved in November and December respectively totaling \$43,072; one for additional casing due to actual driling depths and one for underground primary electrical service.

This modification request #3 is for an amount not to exceed \$18,590 for a total #OB19-010 contract amount not to exceed \$614,954.

Modification #3 is needed for well production testing as recommended by MDNR (Missouri Department of Natural Resources) to test conditions of the well for sustained flow of 500 gpm.

OB19-010 Swiss Village Well No.3 was a FY2019 budgeted project with a portion of carryover of the project into FY2020. We estimated during the budget process a certain project percentage would be completed and paid in FY2019 (a majority) with only about \$100,000 to be remaining in FY2020. Those estimates were off as a majority of the project will now be completed and paid in FY2020. Once the project is completed a budget amendment to carry over unspent FY2019 budgeted project dollars into the FY2020 budget.

Dear Kim Ingham,

As per discussions with MDNR, we recommend two additional well production tests be performed at well #3. The tests require that the existing test pump about 70 feet to a depth of 630-640 feet in order to pump well #3 at a sustained flow of 500 gpm. This requires additional pump column pipe and electrical cable. Water drawdown levels will be monitored in both well #3 and the City's closest well, well #1, during the test duration of 6-8 hours of pumping until the water drawdown levels stabilize, followed by 1-2 hours of water level monitoring during recovery to original static water levels. This information will then be utilized in analysis of potential well interference, and to determine the impact, if any, well #3 has on well #1. The second test is the same as the first except with both well #1 and well #3 running. This information from the second test will then be utilized to select the pump for well #3, establish the required pump depth for well #3 and determine if an adequate water level is maintained above the pump in well #1 when both wells are operating for long durations. The contractor provided cost proposals for the first test, which they show as option 2 with a cost of \$9,460.00 and the second test which they show as option 3 with a cost of \$6,655.00 resulting in a total cost for the additional pump tests of \$16,115.00. The additional cost of the first test includes the cost to lower the test pump.

We also recommend that a video inspection of well #3 be performed with the digital video file provided to the City. The well inspection video will show the condition of the drilled well including rock and rock fractures encountered during drilling below the well casing, along with differences in rock strata encountered and will document the total depth of the well. The contractor provided a cost proposal for this video inspection work in the amount of \$2,475.00.

The enclosed change order includes the items above, which result in a total cost of \$18,590.00. Please feel free to contact me with any questions.








OSAGE BEACH TYPICAL MANHOLE
