BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF OSAGE BEACH, AS FOLLOWS, TO WIT:

Section 1. <u>Section 3</u>. That the City Clerk of Osage Beach, Missouri, is hereby authorized and directed to acknowledge this ordinance as deeds are acknowledged, and to cause this ordinance to be filed for record in the Recorder's Office in Camden County, Missouri.

<u>Section 4</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are, in so much as they conflict with this ordinance, hereby repealed.

<u>Section 5</u>. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and approval by the Mayor.


