No Injury Aircraft Incident at Grand Glaize Airport

Osage Beach, MO – On 09/17/2021, at approximately 10:15 AM a M35 Beechcraft attempted a landing on runway 32 at the Grand Glaize Airport in Osage Beach, MO. The aircraft landed gear up on the runway and slid to a stop in the middle of runway 32; no injuries were reported. Subsequently a NOTAM was issued, an alert to aircraft pilots of potential hazards along flight routes. The Grand Glaize Airport runway was shut down for approximately two hours to allow the damaged aircraft to be removed.
