<u>Engineering Dept Update</u>: Bids will soon be going out for the cleaning of Swiss Village Water Tower. Construction on that new well house starts soon.

<u>Transportation Dept Update</u>: We have begun crack-sealing streets in preparation of our slurry seal project, updating surface information of all City and private-owned streets within City Limits. March will be our storm water drainage inspections across the City.

<u>Sewer Department Update</u>: We're working on preventative maintenance on our lift stations and grinder pumps, rebuilding pumps in-house and fixing a gravity line in Tan-Tar-A Estates.

<u>Water Department Update</u>: The department is starting spring maintenance on the wells. Some flushing projects will begin this month.


