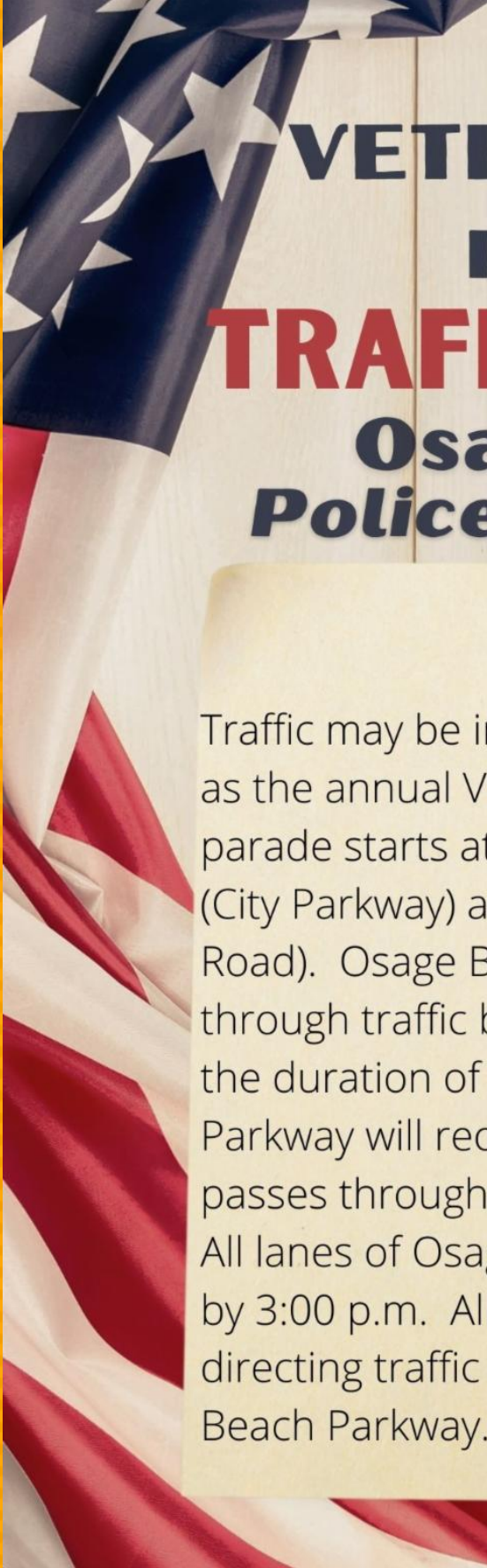

Traffic may be increased on November 07, 2020 as the annual Veterans Day Parade kicks off. The parade starts at 1:00 p.m. beginning at City Hall (City Parkway) and ends at the Elks Lodge (Winn Road). 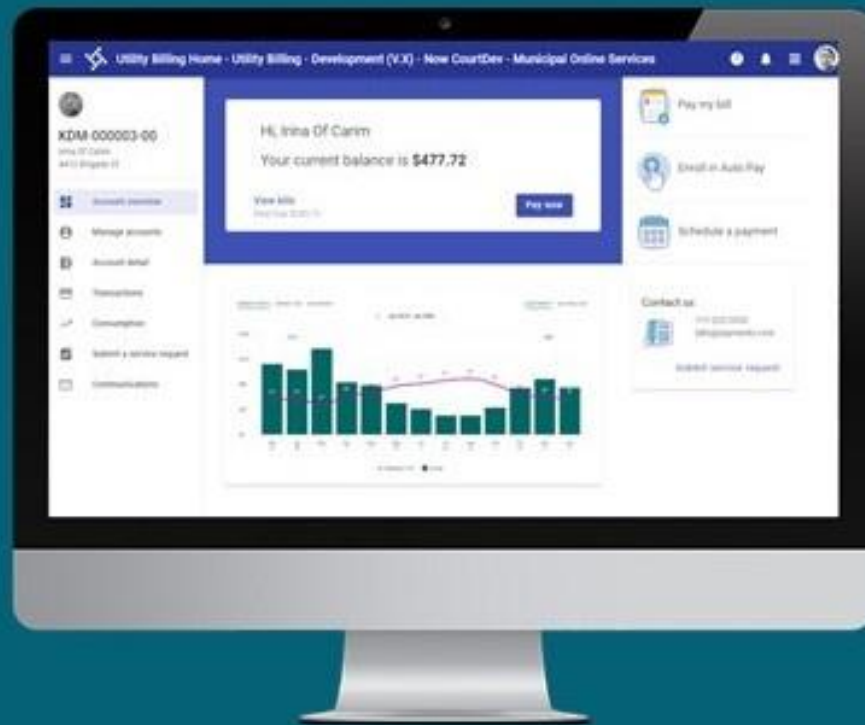
