Message from the City Administrator

Part of our responsibility in providing superior municipal services to our community includes utilizing

our resources wisely and facilitating and maintaining a balanced budget. The operating budget is the City's spending plan which outlines our resource sources and uses, including capital investment into our community.

In the upcoming weeks, the Mayor, Board of Aldermen, and staff will begin the annual budget workshops in preparation for the FY2022 Operating Budget adoption. The FY2022 Operating Budget Draft #1 has been distributed to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, supporting a nearly \$31.3 million dollar spending plan. The draft budget for FY2022 outlines over \$8.6 million in capital investment into our City, including park and transportation projects, and water, sewer, and airport infrastructure. Three budget workshops are scheduled for the end of October and are open to the public. The draft budget can be downloaded [HERE](#).

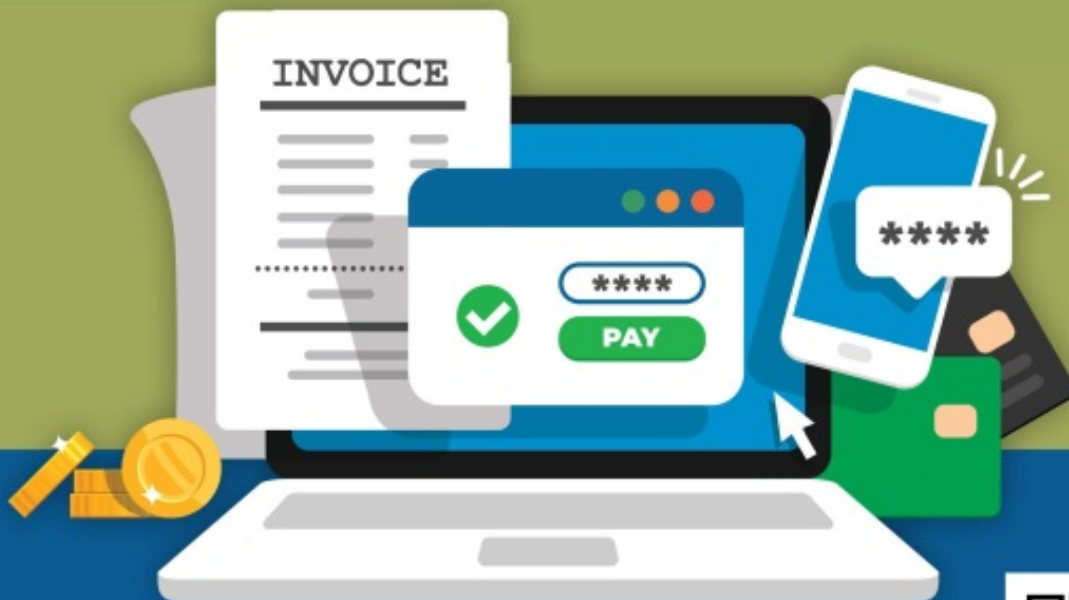

City Resident Responsibilities

- Property owners are to rake leaves to the ditches, road side, or edge of their property,
- Leaves may also be bagged in special ENVIRONMENTAL LEAF BAGS, available at City Hall and Public Works,
- Pick-up is only available on public streets owned by the City; however, for those who live on private roads in City limits, bags dropped off by the public streets will be picked up.
