FURTHER EXCEPTING THEREFROM a 40.0 foot wide roadway known as Ash Lane, lying in parts of Block F and Bock G of Osage Beach Harbor Subdivision, a subdivision recorded in Plat Book 6, Page 17, Camden County, Missouri and lying 20.0 feet on both sides of the following described centerline: Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 20 of First Addition to Oak Run, a subdivision recorded in Plat Book 20, Page 28, Camden County, Missouri, located in the centerline of a 40.0 foot wide road and running along said centerline the following bearings and distances: North 38 degrees 49 minutes West, 63.3 feet; North 59 degrees 57 minutes West, 99.6 feet (old deed = North 58 degrees 20 minutes West 97.7 feet) to the P.C. of a 82.43 degree (old deed = 77 degree) curve to the right; thence along said curve in a Northwesterly direction, 52.5 feet (old deed = 52.9 feet) to the P.T. of said curve, North 16 degrees 39 minutes West 157.7 feet (old deed = North 17 degrees 35 minutes West 157.5 feet), North 15 degrees 59 minutes West, 140.9 feet; North 27 degrees 57 minutes West, 70.9 feet; North 28 degrees 29 minutes West, 159.9 feet; and North 55 degrees 14 minutes West, 10.8 feet to the Southeasterly right of way of S.K. FURTHER EXCEPTING THEREFROM a 40.0 foot wide roadway known as Ash Lane, lying in parts of Block F and Bock G of Osage Beach Harbor Subdivision, a subdivision recorded in Plat Book 6, Page 17, Camden County, Missouri and lying 20.0 feet on both sides of the following described centerline: Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 20 of First Addition to Oak Run, a subdivision recorded in Plat Book 20, Page 28, Camden County, Missouri, located in the centerline of a 40.0 foot wide road and running along said centerline the following bearings and distances: North 38 degrees 49 minutes West, 63.3 feet; North 59 degrees 57 minutes West, 99.6 feet (old deed = North 58 degrees 20 minutes West 97.7 feet) to the P.C. of a 82.43 degree (old deed = 77 degree) curve to the right; thence along said curve in a Northwesterly direction, 52.5 feet (old deed = 52.9 feet) to the P.T. of said curve, North 16 degrees 39 minutes West 157.7 feet (old deed = North 17 degrees 35 minutes West 157.5 feet), North 15 degrees 59 minutes West, 140.9 feet; North 27 degrees 57 minutes West, 70.9 feet; North 28 degrees 29 minutes West, 159.9 feet; and North 55 degrees 14 minutes West, 10.8 feet to the Southeasterly right of way of S.K. Drive, a 40.0 foot wide road shown on the plat of Osage Beach Harbor Subdivision, for the point of termination.

Bearings are based on the South Line of Block F of Osage Beach Harbor Subdivision being South 80 degrees 30 minutes.
