New Public Works Director Appointed by Osage Beach Mayor & Board of Aldermen

Osage Beach, Mo. – A new Public Works Director is joining the City of Osage Beach.

Mayor Michael Harmison formally appointed Jeffrey Fisher to the position during the May 16, 2025, Regular Board of Aldermen Meeting at Osage Beach City Hall. All present Aldermen approved Fisher's appointment (Alderman Phyllis Marose was absent and did not vote).

Fisher's career in local government spans more than two decades. He was most recently employed with the Kansas City, Missouri, Public Works Department. Fisher's previous experience includes Public Works Director for the Unified Government of Wyandotte County and Kansas City, Kansas, and the municipalities of Belton, Missouri and Grain Valley, Missouri.

Fisher was sworn in immediately following the meeting by City Clerk Tara Berreth, as shown in the attached photograph. He is expected to begin the week of May 19th.

The Public Works Director is an appointed position chosen by the Mayor with the advice and consent of a majority of the Board of Aldermen, per ordinance section 115.390.
